

NOTICE OF ESTABLISHMENT OF METHODOLOGIES FOR
AND AMOUNTS OF SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT FEES FOR THE USE AND
AVAILABILITY OF, AND BENEFITS CONFERRED BY,
THE SYSTEM AND PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on November 21, 2013, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of Amsterdam-Churchill County Sewer District No. 307, Montana (the "District"), adopted a Resolution of Intention of the Amsterdam-Churchill County Sewer District No. 307, Montana to Establish Methodologies For and Amounts of System Development Fees for the Use and Availability of, and Benefits Conferred By, the System (the "Resolution"). The Resolution is available for inspection at the District office, located at 7200 Churchill Road, Manhattan, Montana, during normal business hours.

The District proposes establishing System Development Fees. The proposed System Development Fees would be charged to new customers that desire to connect to the District's wastewater system (the "System") based on the use of the property being connected to the System and, for nonresidential property, the recommended water meter service size for the property proposed to be connected to the System based on American Water Works Association Manual M22 ("AWWA M22"), "Sizing Water Service Lines and Meters."

For residential property, the amount of the System Development Fee is proposed to be as follows:

<u>Residential</u>	<u>Per Dwelling Unit</u>
Single family detached	\$4,774
All other dwelling types	\$2,326

For nonresidential property, the System Development Fee shall be based upon the appropriate water meter size for the property proposed to be connected to the System under the standard set forth in AWWA M22, Table 6-1 (as set forth below). Owners of nonresidential property desiring to connect to the System shall, provide the District Manager with water flow rate requirements for the property proposed to be connected to the System based on AWWA M22, Table 6-1. The System Development Fee for nonresidential service connections to the System will be based on this methodology and will be as described below, whether or not a meter is actually installed in connection with the water service.

<u>Nonresidential</u>	<u>Per Meter Size</u>
3/4"	\$4,774
1"	\$8,545
1 1/2"	\$19,095
2"	\$34,086

It is proposed that the full amount of the System Development Fee be paid by the new customer to the District prior and as a condition to connecting to the System.

A public hearing on the proposed System Development Fee will be held at the Amsterdam Rural Fire Department meeting hall, located at 7170 Churchill Road in Manhattan, Montana, on December 12, 2013, at 4:00 p.m. Further information about the proposed rates and charges or information concerning the Resolution may be obtained by contacting Henry Dyksterhouse, President of the Board of the District, at (406) 282-7291.
